Camp Incredible 2022 - Information, Policies, and Procedures

Dates and Times

Our summer program will consist of six one-week camps as follows:

Session 1: June 6-10
Session 2: June 13-17

Session 3: June 20-24
Session 4: June 27- July 1

Session 5: July 11-15
Session 6: July 18-22

All camp sessions are Monday-Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Extended day available for additional fee.

Fees

Two weeks of Camp Incredible 2022 are included in tuition for current USchool students who are enrolled for the 2022-2023 academic year. This benefit does **not** include the cost of Extended Day. Any Extended Day fees will be billed to student's tuition accounts. Fees for additional weeks of camp beyond the two included will also be billed to students' tuition accounts.

- Early Registration - \$225 per session (before April 30, 2022)
- Regular Registration - \$250 per session (after April 30, 2022)

Eligibility

For the 2022 summer camps, registration is open only to University School students.

Fees, based on your enrollment choices, will be billed to your student's tuition account and are due within 30 days of registration.

Grade and Age Levels

All grade levels refer to the grade the student will be entering in the fall of 2022.

Changes

- **Regardless of the reason for changes (except in the case of cancellation due to insufficient enrollment), a \$25 change fee will be charged for each change made to a student's enrollment.**
- Changes must be requested by the Friday before a session is scheduled to begin.
- If you would like to change your student's registration after you have enrolled, you must complete and fill out a Change Form. Email campincredible@utulsa.edu to request this form.

Extended Day

- Extended Day is available in three separate sessions so that you can choose the specific times you need: AM (7:30-9:00), PM1 (3:00-4:00), and PM2 (4:00-5:15).
- Cost per week: AM Session: \$50 PM1 Session: \$50 PM2 Session: \$50
- Extended day program activities are less structured than those in the regular summer camps and will include outdoor play, games, videos, puzzles, etc.
- Students attending afternoon Extended Day should bring a snack.

Late Pickup

Pickup is from 3:00 to 3:10 p.m. Any child not picked up by 3:15 p.m. will be charged a minimum late fee of \$15, plus any applicable Extended Day fees.

Lunch

Students should bring a sack lunch, including a beverage. Lunches should not include soda or candy. Microwaves are available, but items needing to be warmed up should take no longer than 2 minutes in the microwave. Lunch will be supervised. **University School has a no-peanut policy; please do not include peanut products in children's lunches.**

Behavior

Students are expected to have good behavior and follow classroom and school rules at all times. Attendance at our summer program is a privilege, and inappropriate behavior may jeopardize that privilege.

Personal Items

University School is not responsible for personal items brought to camp by students. We prefer that students do not bring personal wireless devices, such as cell phones, e-readers, etc., to camp. If wireless devices are brought to camp, they must be turned off. University School is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of personal items brought to camp.
